

Guidelines for Submission

1. All abstracts must be submitted and presented in English and authors are responsible for the literary standard of submitted abstracts. Please make sure to proof read the abstract.
2. The author submitting the abstract is responsible for its content and quality of preparation. Any errors in spelling, grammar, or scientific fact will be published as typed by the author.
3. The abstract text **is limited to 2.500 characters** (excluding title, authors and affiliations). An example of an abstract construction is shown below.
4. The abstract must be typed in Calibri, 11 pt, with single spacing
5. The title of the study must be written in **capital letters**.
6. All authors must be listed, separated by commas.
The authors' institutional affiliations must be indicated with superscript numbers.
The institutions, likewise numbered, must be separated by semicolons.
7. All abstracts should contain:
a) main objective(s) of the study, b) materials and methods, c) results, d) conclusion.
8. Standard abbreviations must be used. Other abbreviations must be defined in brackets after the first use of the word.
9. Please underline the presenting author among the authors.

Submitted abstracts can be re-uploaded at any time before the deadline (February 28, 2018)

Please note that the presenting author of an accepted abstract is required to register and pay the registration fee, attend the conference and make the presentation of the abstract. Be aware that the abstract will only be published if the presenting author has registered for the meeting and paid the registration fee!
